## Audio/Visual Recording and Photography Policy

### 1. POLICY PURPOSE

To inform volunteers, house of representatives, their constituents, Kalashians, eKailashians, attendees of the free and sacred Bhava Darshan (individually and collectively Attendees).

This policy applies to all bhava darshan, including but not limited to Devi Bhava darshans (Bhava Darshan).

### 2. DEFINITIONS

Recording Device: Any electronic or other device, software or technology used to capture audio and/or visual information and photographs. This includes, but is not limited to, computers, cell phones, cameras, tape recorders and video cameras.

### 3. POLICY DETAILS

3.1. The use of any Recording Device by any Attendees is prohibited.

### 4. PROCEDURES

4.1. It is a violation of this policy to record during Bhava Darshan (including pre Bhava Darshan context setting class, Bhava Darshan and post Bhava Darshan wrap class).

4.2. It is a violation of this policy to publish any recordings of Bhava Darshan.

4.3. Compliance with this policy is mandatory. Violations of this policy may result in discipline up to and including indefinite suspension from all Bhava Darshan and KAILASA programs. Further, appropriate legal action will be applied to all violators.
